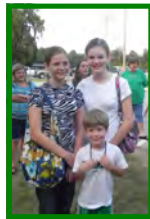

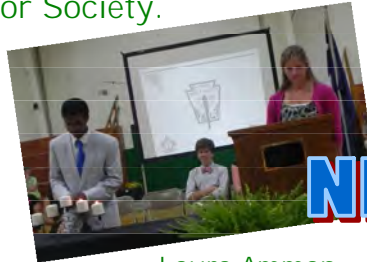
# NHS Induction Ceremony
